

Harry Laurence WALLIN

Private 1st Battalion. The Border Regt. 87 Brigade 29th Division Army No. 33800 formerly with Royal Field Artillery no. 178364.

Killed in action on 19 May, 1917 in the Somme aged 23 years.

Son of John Henry and Elizabeth Sophia WALLIN.

Commemorated on Bay 6 of the Arras Memorial as he has no known grave.

Harry was an Adderbury Morris team member who danced along with Ronald and Percy PARGETER and George ROBINS who also lost their lives in the First World War. All four had their names put forward in 2014 to have roads named after them by Adderbury Parish Council for the new housing development on the south side of Milton Road in Adderbury (just past St. Mary's Road) known as Adderbury Fields. The name **WALLIN ROAD** was selected by Cherwell District Council for this site. Adderbury Parish Councillor Paddy LEEMAN (Patricia) made the original suggestion to the council for the road naming to recognise the history of Adderbury Morris.
