This Indenture

made the ^{10th} 21st day of

March One thousand nine hundred and eleven **Benjamin Catharine**
Maria Griffin and **Eugenia Hunter Griffin** of the City of London Spinners of the one part and **William Cox** of Southwark in
the County of Kent Mechanician of the other part **Whereas**

John Griffin late of Banbury in the County of Oxford Esquire duly made his Will dated the ^{12th} 21st day
of May One thousand eight hundred and eighty whereby after making certain
charitable bequests as to his freehold and copyhold estates situate at Banbury and
Readington in the County of Oxford and all the rest and residue of his personal
estate whatsover and wheresoever he devised and bequeathed in same unto
Griffin and Anthony Lawson Mayhew their heirs executors administrators and assigns
respectively to the uses and upon the trusts therein after contained (that was to say)

to such uses upon such trusts and in such manner in all respects as his three
daughters Catharine Maria Griffin Elizabeth Hunter Griffin and Sara Griffin
in the said will and under the said will should and lawfully come to and
said testator and notwithstanding anything by any deed or will directed or appointed or
devised the same and in default of any such direction limitation or

appointment gift or devise then he directed that the same should be held
by his said trustees in trust for his said daughters the said Catharine Maria
Griffin Elizabeth Hunter Griffin and Sara Griffin in equal shares and
proportions as tenants in common and the said testator declared that in case
any of his said daughters should die in his lifetime without
having been married and without having made a will or appointment

therein before contained then the share of such daughter so dying as well
as any of the said real and personal estate should go and be held
by his said trustees upon trust for the survivors of them his said daughters in
equal shares and proportions and in appointed to be **Benjamin Griffin** and
Anthony Lawson Mayhew Executors of that will **And whereas**

the said Sara Griffin died on the ^{10th} 21st day of October One thousand and
eight hundred and eighty three **And whereas** the said John
Griffin died on the fourth day of February One thousand eight hundred and
eighty nine without having made or executed his said will which was
duly proved in the Oxford District Registry on the twenty second day of

March the first and eight hundred and eighty nine before the
 Recorders **Richard Whitehead** by an indenture made the fourth day
 of the said month of March the said William Lee and made witness
 the said William Griffen and Anthony Dawson of the one part and
 the said Catharine Maria Griffen and Elizabeth Hunter Griffen of the other
 part of the county of Middlesex that the said Catharine Maria Griffen and
 Elizabeth Hunter Griffen not being married and making no appointment
 in the said will of the said William Lee the hereditaments therein
 contained to be held by the said William Griffen and Anthony
 Dawson to be conveyed to the same Anthony Dawson in manner hereinafter
 appearing which they the said William Griffen and Anthony Dawson
 themselves had consented to to it was witnessed that in consideration
 of the premises the said William Griffen and Anthony Dawson having
 as such witnesses appeared thereby and consented to the said Catharine
 Maria Griffen and Elizabeth Hunter Griffen (inter alia) the said
 hereditaments therein contained to be held by the said William Griffen
 and Anthony Dawson in equal shares as tenants in common. **Richard**
