We are the Deddington and Parish Covid-19 response team – a group of local volunteers.

We are organised into zones covering Deddington plus a team in each of Clifton and Hempton. Zones are shown on the map below.

Please call us if you need help or information.

This might be to collect shopping or prescriptions, or just for information.

There are well over a hundred volunteers throughout the parish supporting the zone captains and parish council – many thanks to all.

Healthcare

Delmergate: All prescriptions for the over 60s are being delivered automatically and all those on the Government 'Shielding' list. If you are not in these groups, but need assistance getting your prescriptions, please notify your zone captain. Opening hours: 9-1, 3-6:30, Mon-Fri. Tel 337583

Deddington Health Centre: Tel 338611. For repeat prescriptions call 338847 (10-3, Mon-Fri) and please leave a message as paper copies are no longer accepted.

Anyone on the previous DHC delivery system will continue to get deliveries, anyone on the government shielding list who does not have family, friends or volunteer to collect for them can contact the Dispensary on 338862 and delivery will be arranged.

Patients in Hempton or Clifton who ordinarily collect, but now need a prescription delivery, please notify your Zone Captain. Delivery day is Friday.

Dentists: no appointments at present; in an emergency ring your usual practice for advice.

Food Shopping

Co-op: Open 7am-9pm (8-8 on Sunday). VIP Hour 9.30-10.30. Telephone orders can be taken, card payment over the telephone. Zone captains can arrange delivery for those isolating. Tel: 336281

Eagles: Telephone orders taken, payments over the phone. Tel: 338500.

Foodies: Fresh bread, local farm eggs, pasta, rice, flour; also take away hot drinks & deli sandwiches. 10-3 daily. Tel: 337470

Sainsbury's: Open to NHS & Social Care staff on Mon-Sat at 7:30 (30 mins before public opening). Priority shopping from 8:00-9:00 Mon, Wed & Fri.

Morrisons: Will deliver for elderly, vulnerable and self-isolating people ONLY. 0345 611 6111 option 5.

If you are unable to leave home and need shopping from the supermarket, please call your zone captain, we are here to help you! It's that simple.
