DOCTOR'S APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION.—
At Woodstock Rural Tribunal last week Mr. G. M. W. Hedges, medical practitioner, Deddington (36, married), applied for conditional exemption, and was granted temporary exemption to July 2nd, 1918 (on the recommendation of the Central Medical War Committee), or until a commission in the R.A.M.C. was offered by the Army (whichever occurs first), and conditional upon continuance in the meantime in professional practice.
