

THE MURAL PAINTING.

A large painting on canvas has been fitted into the gable at the east end of the New Hall, the work of Tom van Oss, O.D., and oak panelling has been placed below it. The general effect is highly satisfactory, and a vast improvement upon the bare wall, which became inevitably dirty through rubbing at the time of plays and on other occasions when the stage is in being. Subscriptions were invited from O.D.'s and parents to meet the cost of the painting, and the appeal has met with a generous response, but there still remains a sum of £60 to be paid, and anyone willing to help to pay off this deficit is invited to do so.
