
Deddington through Facebook – September

It's that time, again, to give you all an update regarding new COVID-19 restrictions imposed upon us by the government.

On the back of the Covid-19 alert level being raised to level four (transmission is high or rising exponentially), the Prime Minister declared that pubs and restaurants in England must shut their doors by 10PM every evening,

from Thursday 24 September as part of new measures to slow the spread of the virus.

Last orders will be called every evening at 9.15pm, time at 9.45pm and everyone out by 10pm. This will include from all outside areas!

All pubs, bars and restaurants must be table service only. This mean when entering the unicorn, please make your way to the bar where you will be met by a member of staff to allocate you a table, this will still be for a maximum of 6 people at a time, with no groups mixing! We will be leaving a number of tables for drinkers inside the pub and outside NO SERVICE WILL BE FROM THE BAR!

It will now be compulsory for customers to wear face coverings, though not whilst seated and eating or drinking, but when moving around premises (entering, exiting, using facilities etc.). Customers must also be seated outside in the designated areas when smoking.

NON-COMPLIANCE with these new regulations will result in large fines for businesses and customers and we will therefore be following the guidance STRICTLY.

A NHS Test and Trace App has been launched and it is essential to have this in place from 24 September. From the 18th September it was mandatory to collect staff, customer and visitor data. From the 24th September venues including pubs must display a NHS QR code that can be scanned using the NHS Test & Trace app. This is a unique code for our pub that can be registered on and downloaded via the Government website. These will be available from Thursday. We will still also take details manually to ensure compliance.

Please be patient with us and our staff as this will be another new challenge, and we will need time to fine tune our processes.
