

Grave

George Coggins, and his wife Mary, are buried in a low tomb with a coped Latin cross adjacent to the north-west wall of Deddington parish church. The inscriptions have begun to erode.

The inscription on the south facing side of the cross reads:

**Sacred to the memory of
Mary Helen**

**The beloved and loving wife of George COGGINS
who died on the 19th. Jan^y 1899. in the 45th. year of her age**

The inscription on the north facing side of the cross (below) reads:

**Also in loving memory of
George COGGINS,**

**Born December 4th. 1846, died November 1st. 1920,
"In the midst of life we are in death"
May they rest in peace.**
