In the name of God Amen I Anthony Harris Householder of Dadington in the county of Oxon Baker being sick weak in body but of sound and perfect mind memory and understanding (praised be God) for/same and considering the uncertainty of this life do make my last will and testament in manner following that is to say First I will that my debts be paid and funeral expenses be discharged Item I give devise and bequeath unto my loving son John Harris and /his heirs and assigns for ever all that my house with appurtenances situate and being in Dadington aforesaid and now or late in the tenure or occupation of Thomas Bazley labourer or his assigns item I give devise and bequeath unto my loving sons Edward Harris and Anthony Harris and to my loving daughter Margaret Harwood the sum of one guinea apiece to be paid unto them respectively within six months after my decease Item I give devise and bequeath unto my three granddaughters Eliza Mary and Catherine Harris the daughters of my said son Edward the sum of twenty pounds of lawful money of Great Britain that my said son Edward owes and is indebted to me to be equally divided amongst them share and share alike when they shall obtain their respective age of one and twenty years and my will and meaning is I hereby direct and appoint that in case either of my granddaughters Eliza Mary and Catherine shall happen to depart this life
before her or their legacy or legacies shall become due or payable then I give and devise that legacy or legacies of her so dying unto the rest of them share and share alike Item I give and bequeath unto my grandson Edward Harris the son of my son John Harris the best metal potager pot Item I give and bequeath unto my granddaughter Mary Harris the best brass kettle and to my loving granddaughter Judith Harris the biggest brass kettle all the rest and the residue and remainder of my goods and chattels and personal estate whatsoever not herein before disposed I give devise and bequeath unto my said son John Harris he paying all my debts legacies and funeral expenses except two bags of hops which I give and bequeath one to my loving son Edward Harris the other to my said daughter Margaret Harwood Item I do hereby declare make ordain constitute and appoint my son John whole and sole executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me at any time heretofore made in witness whereof I the said Anthony Harris the elder have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal the $27^{\text {th }}$ day of June Anno Domini 1725 Anthony Harris his mark signed sealed published and declared for his last will and testament of the abovenamed Anthony Harris in the presence and as subscribed our names as witnesses thereunto in the presence of testator Anthony Beasly Richard Harris Thomas
