1910 Jan^{ry} Sent telegram
to Jack Harris

1 Feb Went with W T Bennett
Tuesday to King's Sutton

met John Harris there
Father signed codicil
for Jack & myself to be his
executors.

Father was in bed up
stairs at Bert Hermans.
Jack and T Bennett was
a long time getting
father to sign the codicil.
They both asked of me
to go up and try &
persuade father to sign
but I would not agree
because father had told
me several times before
what good straight
forward men the two
both Gill & Hodge were.
and it has proved later
the greatest mistake I

ever made, to allow
T Bennett & J Barni to
persuade father to change
the old executors

22 April Sent Watson 20.00
note book (25)

April 1, 1912 This was
about the time T Bennett
got the Power of Attorney
to sell Father's property
at any time.

8 July Jim here from Vancouver
he told me Bill & May
were wide awake men and
executors.

(29) Feb 28, 1914 T Bennett
& T Smith called and
got father to sign giving
him the Power of Attorney
to sell up to £1.00.

1914

Nov 13 Met Bennett, Toy
Jack Harr at Bennett's
Bennett said he met
father in the street, I
told Bennett he wanted
to give my wife something
Toy said (Mad people
had lucid intervals).

1915

17 Aug Father's grave stone
23 Nov 900

T Bennett told me he
could sell all the land
without our consent or
signatures.

22 Nov 1916 Mr Frank Gray
came had will.

1914

31 Oct moving furniture
to Grove Lodge

Jan 1914

17 Mr Frank Gray
called with will, I
signed & Mr Gibbs paid
106

did not read contents of
will, & Gray said it was
like the other -

26 Feb bought cramps
from Bailey

1914 check

Oct 19 paid Berkley Farms
for mangers, 12 100
stove frank &
partition in stable
at Grove Lodge

Oct I agree to take Grove
Lodge for \$20 from
H C Mason
then I took the Grove Lodge

1920

May 29 Fused War memorial
in church

Jan^r 1920 Letter to
the County Agent
County Hall Oxford
about buying the
Lyne Lodge and
allotments ground -

23 Sep 1919 Copy letter to
Diocesan Registry
Oxford
about Tablet in church

1920

15 Feb Told Mason I would
buy the property
Answered agent letter
12 Mason told me house
was sold

May 27 1920 Paid T Boniface

boy the sailor that moved
them.

Paid S J Hopcraft 12 0 0
for the material of
the 2 cottages in the Grove
Occupied by W Harper
the site having been
sold to me 26 March 1920

Bought house & premises
from Hopcraft 210 0 0

1924
14 Nov Spencer Hopcraft's pig
knocked sheep bees over
some days back, I put
them on the brand again.

30 Sep 1925 ^{Paid} Spencer Hopcraft
Rent garden for bees 1 10 0
He told me to move the
bees away in a month, he

Sheep knocked 3 lots bus
over in small gardens
£6 loss at the lowest they
were in bar from here

X A mistake to move bus
a short distance \Rightarrow
until November

said they could have stayed
if I had moved them when
he asked me some months
back. X

4 Aug Went to France
and Belgium

1932

12 Feb Took deeds to
Midland Bank, arranged
with Mr Gillam about
having overdraft if wanted

1932

Sunday
June 26 Tutting sheep all day
sent off a load

27 M A bad smell in my
garden also in Clarkes

July 3 Sunday Tutting pigs
at 7 a.m.

Nov 1933 Had cerebral
haemorrhage a few days later
