

The (male) Inhabitants of Deddington, Clifton and Hempton - Cartwright papers 1623

The original document consists of two separate lists of names. The main one (about 210 names) is entitled "The Inhabitants of the Mannor of dadington". The second list (title yet to be deciphered) has 9 names from each of Deddington, Clifton and Hempton. The Deddington names are duplicates and are indicated by a "*" against the surname in the main list..

In the second list the Deddington names include 2 gentlemen, the rest being tradesmen. The Clifton list is headed by Shakerley Marmyon, Esquire while the rest of the people are farmers. The Hempton list contains one carpenter and 8 farmers including Hercules Aris, husbandman and Puritan. Until the title of the second list is deciphered we can only guess at it's purpose. Given the equal numbers (9) from each village and the status of the members it looks very much like some sort of court or jury to me.

The first proper entry on the main list is "George French, Bayliffe" but the occupation of Bayliffe has been crossed out and a new entry squashed in above: "Anthony Mercer, Bayliffe." We can only speculate as to why George French no longer has his job.

Note that Anthony Mercer, minus an occupation, also appears in the first column on the reverse but that his name has been crossed through.

Some unanswered questions:

Why are 14 dead people (obiit) included?

Why are some entries crossed out ?

Why do a number of people (15) have no occupation?

I have included my notes or observations at the end of entries, preceded by a "-"
