Class III            Exhibition Inn

"Now a private house and was a ruinous 16-17c structure  
but has recently been restored and partly rebuilt.

Now 2-storeyed rebuilt coursed ironstone rubble with a  
Marley tiled roof and stone stacks, and a large eaves  
dormer in the centre; metal framed casement windows, and a  
bay on the west. The front door is a reused c16-17 stone  
one with deeply moulded jambs and a flattened four-centred  
head with a drip mould; probably brought from elsewhere  
some considerable time ago.
