Michael Hutton of Deddington, Papermaker [6461], 1, 2, 3 son of Michael Hutton of Deddington, papermaker [2200] and Jaell [4007], was born on 7 Oct 1692, died on 21 Jul 1751 aged 58, and was buried on 23 Jul 1751 in Southwark, Surrey.

Noted events in his life were:

- He was born on 7 Oct 1692.<sup>4</sup> Michaell the son of Michael Hutton & Jaell his wife of the papermill was born. 7d 8mo (i.e. 7th October) Registered in Banbury, Oxfordshire.
- He worked as a Papermaker on 11 Oct 1728.5
- He had a residence on 11 Oct 1728 in Deddington, , Oxfordshire, England.<sup>5</sup> of Dedington
- He died on 21 Jul 1751 in Southwark, Surrey. 'Michael Hutton of the Parish called St John in Southwark
  Aged about 60 years who died the Twentyfirst day of the fifth month called July 1757 Searchers report of a
  Fever, was buried the 23rd of the said month in Friends burying Ground near Long Lane Southward'
  N.B. several other burials of individuals who died due to 'convolsions' or 'fever' during this year

Michael married **Sarah Smith of Deddington** [6462]<sup>1, 2, 3</sup> [MRIN: 355135948] on 11 Oct 1728 in Adderbury, Oxford, England, daughter of **Samuel Smith of Shipston upon Stour** [6507] and **Unknown**. Sarah was buried on 22 Sep 1729 in Quakers, Adderbury, Oxford, England. They had one daughter: **Mary**.

Noted events in their marriage were:

- They signed a marriage contract on 11 Oct 1728.<sup>5</sup> Mich'll Hutton & Sarah Smith, 11d 8m 1728 (i.e. 11 Oct 1728). Registered in Banbury, Oxon
- They signed a marriage contract on 11 Oct 1728 in Adderbury, Oxford, England. Full marriage record -Whereas Michael Hutton of Deddington Mill in the county of Oxon PaperMaker and Sarah Smith Deddington aforesaid Spinster (daughter of Samuel Smith late of Shipton upon Stawer inthe county of Worcester dece'd)'....'Eleventh day of the month called October in the year according to the English account 1728.'...'at their public meeting place at Adderbury in the count of Oxford' The list of witnesses is a long one but unfortunately not divided into sections for relatives and others. - She was buried on 22 Sep 1729 in Quakers, Adderbury, Oxford, England.<sup>4</sup> Sarah the wife of Michael
  Hutton of Dedington Paper Mill was buried at Aderbury, 7m 22d 1729 (i.e. 22 sep 1729) entry also refers
  to the burial of Mary her daughter buried nearly two months later

Mary Hutton [797] was born on 15 Sep 1729 in Deddington Mill, Deddington, Oxfordshire, England and was buried on 16 Nov 1729 in Adderbury, Oxford, England.
