Extract from the minutes of the Public Meeting, held
in the Church School Deddington, on 8th Nov 1954:-

" after discussion it was proposed by
M^r G. Clarke, seconded M^r W. G. Sanders, that the money
at present in hand, be given to the parish Council
who should hold it in trust until such time as it
be possible for the money to be used for the erection
of a pavilion in the Castle Grounds "

The purpose of the meeting was "to enquire into
the methods of the disposal of the Coronation Memorial Hall
fund. Prior to that there had been a meeting at
which it had been decided to merge this fund with the
Deddington Coronation Celebrations fund. The relevant extract

from the minutes of that meeting, which was a Public Meeting held in the Town Hall, Deddington, on Thursday, 1st April 1954, is as follows:-

..... Mr J.S. Sand proposed, seconded Mr W. McPitcheon, that the two funds be amalgamated and that this meeting should discuss the disposal of the total sum of £680.3.7½.
