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 The Altitudes are given in Feet above Ordnance Survey Datum (approximate Mean Sea Level at Liverpool).
 Altitudes indicated thus (B.M. 547) refer to Bench Marks on Buildings, Walls, &c. those marked thus (+ 52 1/2) surface levels.
 Note - To convert Decimal parts of an Acre into Roods and Perches, multiply by 4, this will give Roods and Decimals of a Rood, multiply this Decimal by 40 thus obtaining Perches and Decimals of a Perch. Example - .357 = 1 Rood 17-120 Perches
