The Altitudes are given in Feet above Ordnance Survey Datum (approximate Mean Sea Level at Liverpool).

Altitudes indicated thus (8 4/8) refer to Bench Marks on Dedications. Walls are shown marked thus 1/2 in surface level.

Note - To convert Decimal parts of an Acre into Roods and Perches, multiply by 4. This will give Roods and Decimals of a Rood. Example - 357 = 1 Rood 17/100 Perches multiply this Decimal by 40 thus obtaining Perches and Decimals of a Perch. Example - 14 2/100 Perches 14 2/100
