the fields of Davington aforesaid and also all my Cottage Cows  
Boundaries with my Kitchin and Stables formerly disposed  
lying and being in the fields of Davington aforesaid unto & to the  
use of my Son George Silgoc and his heirs for ever out of  
& chargeable nevertheless with the payment of the several  
legacies therein after by me bequeathed that is to say give &  
bequeath all & all and every of my Grand Children the Children  
of my Son Nathaniel Silgoc and also bequeath the sum of  
my Son's the legacy of the sum of ten pounds apiece to be paid  
to them when they shall next after my decease and in case  
any or either of my said Grand Children shall not have attained

 twenty five pounds to be paid to him out of my personal

In Martin Harris and I give and bequeath unto my said son Zarahriaa Dilgoe the legacy or sum of four hundred pounds to be paid to him out of the money he owes me on his note of hand with legacy and the provision therein before made for my said son Zarahriaa Dilgoe I give him in lieu of the messuage or tenement and good or goods or lands I owe to William Bennett with sundry for my said son Zarahriaa Dilgoe in full discharge and satisfaction of all claims and demands owing my said son Zarahriaa Dilgoe or may owe or claim or pretend to have or claim on me for or on account of the rent or reward or cause with and without received for all or hard labour living & being in Sadmington aforesaid which my said son Zarahriaa Dilgoe for his life of the said of the Manor of Sadmington aforesaid and I direct my said son to effectually receive unto my executors debts and demands when required next I give unto my said son Zarahriaa Dilgoe the sum of four pounds to be distributed by him in two penny leaves amongst the most indigent in or inhabitants of Sadmington in such manner as he shall think fit within one month after my decease to the last mentioned legacy I direct may be paid unto my said son Zarahriaa Dilgoe for his uses aforesaid in ten days next after my decease by my executors next I give and bequeath unto my son in law Joseph Hill the sum of one hundred pounds in money to be paid at the time of my decease and I do direct that the said sum for the same may be given up to him next I give and bequeath all my goods chattels furniture plate books ready money debts & securities for money & all money to me due and owing not lawfully by law my will or disposal of and all other my personal estate whatsoever subject to the payment of my debts legacies funeral expenses and the charges of proving the same my will into my said son Zarahriaa Dilgoe & Zarahriaa Dilgoe to be equally parted & divided between them I do hereby constitute and appoint the said Zarahriaa Dilgoe & Zarahriaa Dilgoe and Zarahriaa Dilgoe and Zarahriaa Dilgoe joint executors of the said my last will and testament hereby revoking and making void all former wills by me at any time since before made bearing witness ratifying & confirming the same to do & for my last will and testament in witness whereof I the said Zarahriaa Dilgoe have to this my last will and testament contained in three sheets of paper and written & sealed been read over to me & my said son and I do hereby to say my said to the bottom of the first two sheets thereof & my said son to the said last and next sheet thereof I do say & bear first written written by Zarahriaa Dilgoe O.
