Shopping

Co-op: Open 7am-8pm (8-8 on Sunday). VIP Hour 9.30-10.30. Telephone orders can be taken, card payment over the telephone. Zone captains can arrange delivery for those isolating. Tel: 336281

Eagles: Telephone orders taken, payments over the phone. Tel 338500.

Foodies: Fresh bread, local farm eggs, pasta, rice, flour; also take away hot drinks & deli sandwiches. 10-3 daily. Tel: 337470

Sainsbury's: Open to NHS staff on Mon-Sat at 7:30 (half-an-hour before public opening). Priority shopping from 8:00-9:00 Mon, Wed & Fri.

Morrisons: Will deliver for elderly, vulnerable and self-isolating people ONLY. Payment by card. 0345 611 6111 option 5.

If you are unable to leave home and need shopping from the supermarket, please call your zone captain, we are here to help you! It's that simple.

Fenemore Farms Micro Farm Shop, in Clifton, is open daily (8-5:30) for frozen lamb, honey, eggs, milk plus pasta, various flours (including GF) and yeast. Also plants from UGM nursery. Cash or cheque only. Tel: 07917 795207.

Deddington Farmers Market: Whilst the Market sadly cannot go ahead at this time, many of the stall holders are providing delivery services. Please see their Facebook page, the market website www.deddingtonfarmersmarket.co.uk, or contact your zone captain for details.

Cotefield Nurseries: Tel 01295 265422/275222 for telephone orders and to arrange a collection slot. Harriet Palin (338850) is co-ordinating a weekly delivery for those isolating; please call her for details. Bedding plants now coming into stock.

Cana Wine merchants (canaimport.co.uk) take web orders and delivery is free to Deddington for more than two cases.

Cyclogical is open 9:30-4 for all things bicycle!

Health and Dispensary

Delmergate Dispensary: Tel 337583. (9-1, 3-6:30, Mon-Fri). Any patients over 60 and anyone on the Government 'Shielding' list will automatically have their prescription delivered to their home.

If you need assistance getting prescriptions to you, please contact your zone captain.

Deddington Health Centre: Tel 338611. For repeat prescriptions call 338847 (10-3, Mon-Fri) and leave a message. (Paper copies no longer accepted.)

If you need assistance getting prescriptions to you, contact your zone captain.

Anyone over 60 or on the Government 'Shielding' list will have prescriptions delivered to the door.

Anyone already on the delivery system, this will continue as normal.

Patients in Hempton or Clifton who need a prescription delivered to their home, please notify your Zone Captain. Delivery day is Friday.

Dentist: emergency appointments only at most local dentists, ring your usual practice if needed.

Pets

Crofts: Bea Maloney (337717) organises a weekly delivery; please call her for details of ordering.

Vets are generally running an emergency service only; ring your usual vet if needed.

Animal vaccinations: Hook Norton Veterinary Group are offering vaccination appointments on specific days. The next dates for these clinics are the 21st and 22nd of April. To book a vaccination appointment on one of these days please use the online booking request form so the telephone is kept free for emergencies. One of the team will then call you to book the appointment. If you do not have access to the internet then please phone.

Dog Poo Bags: if you can't get any, then your zone captain should be able to help.

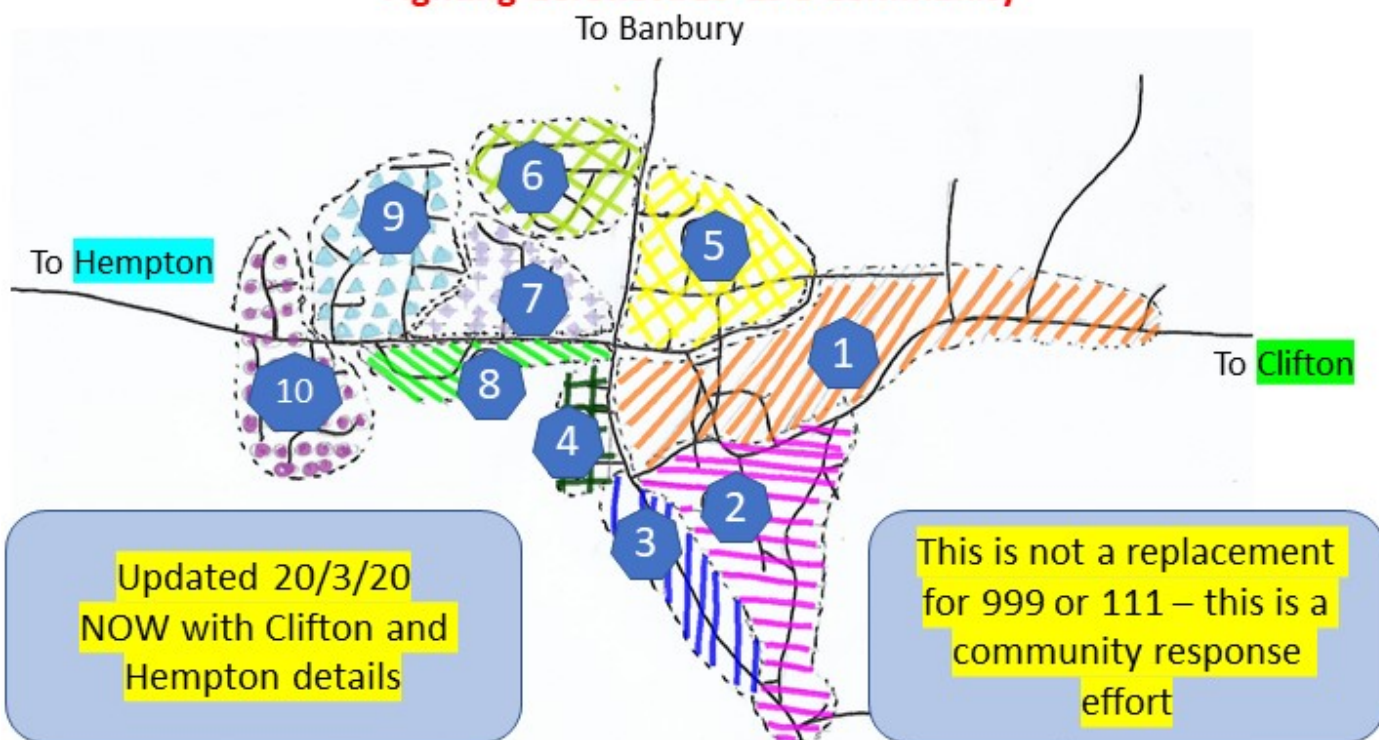
Deddington COVID-19 Response
