This Indenture made the first day of October
One thousand eight hundred and eighty
eight Between Devereux Howe of Deddington in the County
of Oxford Butcher of the one part and George Rogers of Plummers Farm
in the parish of Caversham in the County of Wrothampton Farmer
Richard James Berridge of Sonatori in the County of
Oxford Farmer and John James Godwin of Troy Farm Sonatori
aforesaid Farmers of the other part Whereas the said Devereux
Howe is absolutely seized in fee simple in possession free from all
incumbrances of the messuage or tenement hereditaments and premises
hereinafter described and whereas by a Policy of Assurance dated
the seventh day of July one thousand eight hundred and fifty six
and under the hands and seals of three of the Directors of the
Star Life Assurance Society the sum of One hundred pounds with
bonuses was assured to be paid to the executors administrators or
assigns of Thomas Dean of Deddington in the County of Oxford
Butcher within fifty days after proof of his decease subject to the
annual premium of Two pounds and ten shillings and whereas
by an Indenture dated the thirtieth day of December one thousand
eight hundred and twenty two and made between the said Thomas
Dean of the one part and the said Devereux Howe of the other part
for the valuable consideration therein mentioned the said Thomas Dean
absolutely assigned unto the said Devereux Howe his executors
administrators and assigns the said Policy of Assurance and the sum
of One hundred pounds thereby assured and all other monies bonuses
benefits and advantages under the said Policy and whereas the
said George Rogers Richard James Berridge and John James Godwin
have agreed at the request of the said Devereux Howe to lend to him
the sum of One hundred and twenty five pounds upon having the
repayment thereof with interest paid to them in manner
hereinafter expressed Now this Indenture witnesseth that in
consideration of the sum of One hundred and Twenty five pounds
paid to the said Devereux Howe by the said George Rogers Richard
James Berridge and John James Godwin or otherwise the execution of
these presents out of monies belonging to them on a joint account (the
receipt whereof the said Devereux Howe hereby acknowledges) the said
Devereux Howe hereby covenants with the said George Rogers Richard
James Berridge and John James Godwin to pay to them on the
first day of April next the sum of One hundred and
twenty five pounds with interest thereon in the meantime after the
rate of Four pounds and ten shillings per cent per annum computed

from the date of these presents And also so long after that day as any
principal money remains due under these presents to pay to them interest
thereon after the same rate by equal half yearly payments on the first-
day of April and the ~~first~~^{first} day of October And this
Indenture further witnesseth that for the consideration aforesaid
the said Devereux Rose as beneficial owner hereby conveys to the said George
Rogers Richard James Berridge and John James Godwin all that messuage
or tenement with the outbuildings yard garden and appurtenances to the
same belonging situated standing and being in Duddington aforesaid in a
certain street called New Street or High Street formerly occupied by Samuel
Mason or his undertakers afterwards by George French and John Ward
and now by the said Devereux Rose and his undertakers to hold the
same unto and to the use of the said George Rogers Richard James Berridge
and John James Godwin in fee simple subject to the power for redemption
hereinafter contained And this Indenture also witnesseth that for
the consideration aforesaid the said Devereux Rose as beneficial owner hereby
assigns unto the said George Rogers Richard James Berridge and John James
Godwin all that the hereinbefore recited Policy of Assurance and all
money assured by or to become payable under the same to hold the
same unto the said George Rogers Richard James Berridge and John
James Godwin Provided always that if the said sum of One hundred
and twenty five pounds with interest thereon shall be paid on the
first day of April next according to the foregoing covenant in
that behalf the said messuage and habitaments policy and premiss shall
at the request and cost of the said Devereux Rose his executors administrators
or assigns be reconveyed and reassigned to him or them or as he or they
shall direct And the said Devereux Rose hereby covenants with the said
George Rogers Richard James Berridge and John James Godwin that he the
said Devereux Rose his heirs and assigns will at all times during the
continuance of this security keep the messuage and buildings comprised
herein insured against loss or damage by fire in the sum of one hundred
and twenty five pounds at least in the Guardian Insurance Office or in
some other Insurance Office approved by the said George Rogers Richard
James Berridge and John James Godwin their executors administrators or
assigns and will on demand produce to them the policy of such insurance
and the receipt for every premium payable in respect thereof And the
said Devereux Rose hereby further covenants with the said George Rogers
Richard James Berridge and John James Godwin that he the said Devereux
Rose will not at any time do any act or commit any default whereby the
aforesaid Policy of assurance on the life of the said Thomas Dean may be
rendered void or voidable and will duly and regularly pay the premium and

shall be repaid by the said Duvaux Kore on demand and shall in the
meantime be charged on the hantements and policies of assurance, for the time
being subject to this security in addition to the said principal sum of
One hundred and seventy five pounds and the interest thereon IN WITNESS
