chattels whatsoevir to doe and dispone with att her owne free  
will and pleasure and I doo hereby nominate for mytute -  
and appoynt my said loving wife Anne whole and sole  
Exeuctor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking  
all other wills by me made In witness whereof I have set my  
hande and seale to this my last will and testament sett my hande  
and seal to this pce and twentynote day of November one  
Thos. anno regni Henrici etiatis p. i.
