pleased to bestow upon me I give and bequeath as followeth
first I will that all my debts and severall Expenses of Law
and Sundry other things and bequeath into my dear
and loving wife Anne all and singular my goods and
 Chattels whatsoever to doe and dispose with all her own free
will and pleasure and to do hereby nominate constitute
and appoint my said loving wife Anne whole and sole
Executrix of this my last will and testament hereby revoking
all other wills by me made In witness whereof the said John
Loyatt have to this my last will and testament set my hand
and Seal this five and twentieth day of November one
thousand six hundred and fifty five.
