

## DEDDINGTON.

On Saturday night last a large hay rick, situated in Dunstew field, and belonging to Benjamin Pritchett, a farmer of this town, caught fire in consequence of its being carried before it was properly made. The parish engines were had down at ten o'clock, and were kept there the whole of the night, but only one end of the rick was preserved, and that appears to be of little use. The fire kept breaking out at intervals, in the hay which was spread over the ground, up to five o'clock on Sunday evening. A portion of an old rick, standing near the one which ignited, was not damaged, as the evening was perfectly calm, otherwise this would have probably shared the fate of the other.
